

Corus Channel Sunsets FAQ
Effective September 1, 2025

1. What is happening to ABC Spark, Nickelodeon, Disney XD, Disney Jr., and La Chaîne Disney (Disney French)?

Corus has made the decision to cease distribution of these channels in Canada. As of September 1, 2025 at 12:01 a.m. ET, the following channels will no longer be available:

- ABC Spark
- Nickelodeon
- Disney XD
- Disney Jr.
- La Chaîne Disney (Disney French)

This decision reflects evolving viewing habits, especially among children and families, and Corus' continued focus on offering content in formats and platforms that best serve today's audiences.

2. Why are these channels being shut down?

Corus regularly evaluates its portfolio to ensure alignment with both consumer demand and strategic distribution goals. The decision to sunset these channels follows a broader industry shift in how kids consume content and where families choose to watch.

While these channels will no longer be available, much of the beloved programming will continue to live on other Corus channels like Cartoon Network, Boomerang, YTV, Treehouse, and Disney Channel. We encourage customers to explore these channels for continued access to popular kids and family content.

3. Where can I watch similar content going forward?

Corus remains committed to delivering premium kids and family content. Here's where you can continue to find similar programming:

- **DISNEY CHANNEL** will now be the home to all your favourite Disney shows — from preschool favourites to big-kid adventures — all in one place.
 - New Disney Jr. and Disney XD programming blocks within Disney Channel featuring new and returning shows such like: Mickey Mouse Clubhouse, Iron Man & His Awesome Friends, Bluey Minisodes, Super Kitties, Spidey & His Amazing Friends, Ariel, Firebuds and more!
 - Disney Channel will also continue to offer hit shows such as Wizards Beyond Waverly Place, Kiff, Vampirina, Biggest Band, and the latest season of Phineas and Ferb
 - This change means a simpler, more unified Disney experience for families, with top content from across the Disney universe available on the one Disney channel audiences know and love.
- **YTV** will continue to be the home of exclusive comedy shows like Megamind Rules! Also offering trailblazing shows like Teen Titans GO! As well as top tier Big Fun Movies for kids and their families to enjoy.
- **TREEHOUSE** will continue to be devoted to pre-school children from breakfast to bedtime. Our premium line-up will offer Paw Patrol, Rubble & Crew, Peppa Pig as well as Sesame Street.

- **TÉLÉTOON** (French) will offer a variety of youth programming for French-speaking audiences, shows like Teen Titans GO!, Total DramaRama, Looney Tunes Cartoons, Rubble & Crew.

5. What messaging will customers see on TV?

On-screen lower-third messaging will appear starting August 11, 2025, during programming blocks on the impacted channels. Messaging will state that the channel will be discontinued as of September 1, 2025.

Examples include:

- **Nickelodeon:** “This channel will no longer be available as of September 1, 2025. Enjoy great kids shows on YTV.”
- **Disney Jr.:** “This channel will no longer be available as of September 1, 2025. Disney Jr. shows are available on Disney Channel.”

No continuous crawls or pop-ups will be implemented unless required for accessibility.

6. What will happen to the websites for these channels?

All related channel websites (e.g., abcspark.ca, nickcanada.com, etc.) will be taken offline as of September 1, 2025. Visitors will be redirected to www.corusent.com/our-brands/ or directed to related active Corus properties.

7. Why are other kids channels like YTV, Treehouse, and Cartoon Network staying?

Corus continues to offer a variety of popular kids programming through other channels that remain part of many TV packages. Channels like YTV, Treehouse, TÉLÉTOON+, Cartoon Network, and Boomerang continue to offer family-friendly content that resonates with Canadian families.
